



Tigran Karapet Simonyan was born on November 3, 1988 in the city of Yerevan. In 2008 he graduated with honors from the Faculty of Physics of Yerevan State University, received a Bachelor's degree with honors in physics and a diploma in pedagogy. In 2010 he graduated from Yerevan State University, Faculty of Physics, with a Master's degree in physics.

Tigran Simonyan has participated in a number of qualification courses in Armenia and abroad. In February-July 2008 he participated in the Internet Technology Training Program, receiving a certificate from Sun Microsystems, Enterprise Incubator Foundation (EIF), the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) and the Yerevan State University for Web Technologies of Internet Technology Training Program, PHP, JAVA, Object Oriented Programming, Databases, Project Management and Quality Assurance courses.
